## Rates for the 2011 Season

**MEMBERSHIP FEES:** There is a one time membership fee for new members of \$50 per person with a maximum family charge of \$200. Any charge of \$150 or more may be paid (split) over two seasons. Once this fee is paid, it is paid for life.

**FAMILY ANNUAL DUES:** \$255      **SINGLE ANNUAL DUES:** \$155

**HALF SEASON DUES:** After July 15, Family Dues drop to \$130 and singles drop to \$80

**MAINTENANCE FUND:** \$20 (include this with your dues if you do not help during one of the clean up days)

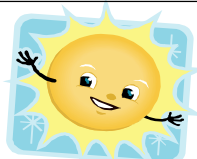
**THCC DEFINITION OF FAMILY:** Our favorite group of people who live at the same address in a parent-child relationship.

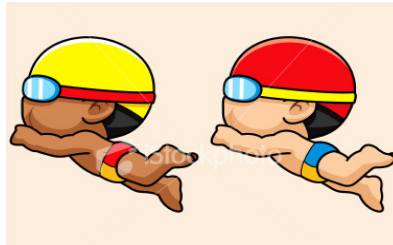
**GUEST FEES**

Please remember to review the pool rules and guidelines with your family (they are available online or at the front desk). The majority of pool accidents, including spinal injuries, happen to children between the ages of 10 and 17 due to horseplay or rough housing. Please remind your children to always listen to the guard's instructions.

## POOL RENTAL

As always, the pool can be rented by members either during or after regular hours. Parties at night can be held until 11:30pm. There is a non-refundable \$30 reservation fee that must be paid before the party date is reserved. There is also a \$20 deposit that will be given back to you if the pool/picnic shelter is cleaned up after the party. Guest fees will be charged for your non-member guests. Parties after hours must hire a minimum of 2 lifeguards at \$10 an hour per guard. Parties of 15 or more during pool hours will have to hire an extra guard for \$10 an hour due to the increased number of people at the pool.
